The eggs in our incubator are scheduled to hatch the second week in April. Take a field trip down to the Cheetah (1st grade) room to take a look!

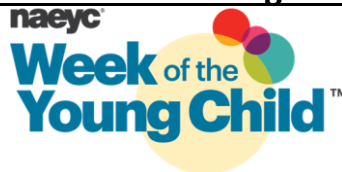
